

THE BICHON FRISE CLUB OF GREAT BRITAIN  
CURRENT JUDGES LIST CRITERIA

A1 LIST.

For persons who have previously been approved by the Kennel Club to award CCs in the breed and have completed their first appointment and have the support of The Bichon Frise Club of Great Britain.

A2 LIST

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of The Bichon Frise Club of Great Britain.

A3 LIST (Breed Specialist )

- = Minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and have the support of the Bichon Frise Club of Great Britain.
- = To have judged one Bichon Frise Club Show
- = To have judged a minimum of 70 dogs
- = To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book (Save in exceptional circumstances.) (K.C. policy)
- = To have stewarded at shows over a period of 12 days (KC policy)
- = To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures (K.C .policy)
- = To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement (K.C .policy)
- = To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (K.C. policy)

A3 LIST (Non Specialist)

- = Minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed ( to include 5 years in this breed) and to have the support of The Bichon Frise Club of Great Britain. (K.C. policy)
- = To have judged at one Bichon Frise Club Show
- = To have judged a minimum of 70 dogs in this breed (K.C. policy)
- = To have awarded CCs in at least one other breed. (K.C. policy)
- = To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances)
- = To have stewarded at shows over a period of 12 days.(K.C.policy)
- = To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures (K.C. policy)
- = To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Confirmation and Movement.(K.C. policy)
- = To have attended a Conformation & Movement “Hands on Assessment” conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment.
- = To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practise and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.

#### B LIST (Breed Specialists)

- = To have 6 years experience owning and exhibiting in this breed and have the support of The Bichon Frise Club of Great Britain.
- = To have attended at least one Bichon Frise judging related seminar and passed an assessment where applicable.
- = To have judged 25 dogs of this breed at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs

#### B LIST (Non Specialist)

- = To have judged 50 dogs of this breed or To have judged 25 dogs of this breed if award cc's in another breed.
- = Minimum of 6 years judging experience in any one breed and have the support of The Bichon Frise Club of Great Britain.
- = To have attended one Bichon Frise Judging related seminar and passed an assessment where applicable.

#### C LIST

For aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of The Bichon Frise Club of Great Britain.
