

## THE BICHON FRISE CLUB OF GREAT BRITAIN - JUDGES LIST CRITERIA

### A1 LIST

For persons who have previously been approved by the K.C. to award CCs in the breed and have completed their first appointment and have the support of the B.F.C.G.B.

### A2 LIST

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with K.C. for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of B.F.C.G.B.

### A3 LIST(Breed Specialist)

Minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and have the support of the B.F.C.G.B.

To have judged one Bichon Frise Club Show

To have judged a minimum of 100 dogs

To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book (Save in exceptional circumstances) (K.C.policy)

To have stewarded at 12shows (K.C.policy)

To have attended a seminar given by a K.C. Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on K.C.Regulations and Judging Procedures (K.C.policy)

To have attended a seminar given by a K.C. Accredited Trainer on Confirmation and Movement (K.C.Policy)

To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant K.C. Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable (K.C.Policy)

### A3 LIST (Non Specialist)

Minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (to include 5 years in this breed) and to have the support of the B.F.C.G.B

(K.C.Policy)

To have judged at one Bichon Frise Club Show

To have judged a minimum of 125 dogs in the breed.

To have awarded Ccs in at least one other breed

To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in the K.C.Stud Book (Save in exceptional circumstances)

To have stewarded at 12 shows (K.C.policy)

To have attended a seminar given by a K.C. Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examination on K.C.Regulations and Judging Procedures (K.C. Policy)

To have attended a seminar given by a K.C.Accredited Trainer on Confirmation and Movement (K.C. Policy)

To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant K.C. Code of Best Practise and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.

### B LIST (Breed Specialists)

To have 6 years experience owning and exhibiting in this breed and have the support of the B.F.C.G.B.

To have attended at least one Bichon Frise judging related seminar and passed an assessment where applicable

To have judged 25 dogs of this breed at Open Shows or Championship Shows without Ccs

### B LIST (Non Specialist)

To have judged 50 dogs of this breed

Minimum of 6 years judging experience in any one breed and have the support of the B.F.C.G.B.

To have attended one Bichon Frise Judging related seminar and passed an assessment where applicable.

### C LIST

For aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the B.F.C.G.B.
